Day 1: DAY 1: AUCKLAND

Day 2: DAY 2: AUCKLAND - WAITOMO - HOBBITON - ROTORUA

Continue to Matamata for a charming tour of unique, character Hobbit homes, gardens, and the watering hole, just as you see in the movies. Finishing off a visually fulfilling day, continue to Rotorua, a bubbling and steaming destination like nowhere else.

Buildings were constructed in the Art Deco style with Maori motifs to give the city a unique New Zealand character. Today, the delightful seaside city of Napier has the extraordinary feeling of a time capsule with its seamless line of some of the world's finest 1930's architecture. Enjoy a guided tour of Napier's unique history and architecture.
