



## Discovering Croatia's Coast to Greece - 12 nights - 13 days

### Day 1: DAY 01 – SPLIT

**Arrival transfer to SPLIT**, a city that combines monumental history with a relaxed Mediterranean lifestyle, making it perfect to explore on foot. **Free day to discover the city.** On your own, you can visit Diocletian's Palace, the heart and soul of Split, and its beautiful seaside promenade, the Riva, an ideal place for a stroll, enjoying a coffee, or dining with views of the Adriatic Sea.

### Day 2: DAY 02 – SPLIT – BRA? ISLAND – BOL ISLAND

From **SPLIT**, we **board a ferry** to the **ISLAND OF BRA?**, one of the most beautiful islands in the Adriatic, surrounded by deep blue seascapes and rugged coastlines. We travel through the island's interior, passing olive groves and stone walls, to Donji Humac, where we **visit the Jakšić Gallery (entrance included)**, a reflection of the local sculptural tradition.



(Discover the renowned Jakšić Gallery on Bra? Island, where Croatian stone artistry and contemporary sculptures come together in an inspiring cultural setting.)

We enjoy a **traditional Croatian brunch (included)** at a typical konoba, then continue **up to Vidova Gora**, the highest point of the Adriatic islands, offering unforgettable views of the Dalmatian Coast and the famous Zlatni Rat beach. The day ends in Bol, a charming seaside town, with free time to stroll along the waterfront or relax on its crystal-clear beaches.

### **Day 3: DAY 03 – BOL ISLAND – HVAR ISLAND – JELSA**

The day begins in **BOL**, with free time to enjoy the Adriatic Sea and relax on the famous Zlatni Rat beach, known for its crystal-clear waters. A unique natural setting to enjoy the island's charm at a leisurely pace.



(Experience the charm of Hvar Island, famous for its crystal-clear waters, historic harbor, vibrant nightlife, and Mediterranean beauty.)

In the afternoon, **we board a catamaran to HVAR ISLAND**, sailing through turquoise waters and past small islands. Arrival in **JELSA**, a quiet harbor with a Mediterranean feel. **Transfer to the hotel** and overnight stay.

### **Day 4: DAY 04 – JELSA – KOR?ULA ISLAND**

Free morning in **HVAR** to stroll through one of the Adriatic's most exclusive destinations, renowned for its elegant Venetian architecture, white stone alleyways, and lively Mediterranean atmosphere.



(Explore the timeless beauty of Korčula Island, known for its medieval architecture, coastal scenery, and rich Croatian heritage.)

In the afternoon, **we take a ferry to KORCULA ISLAND**, sailing through a seascape dotted with small islands and deep blue waters. Arrival in Korčula, a walled town with a strong medieval character, famous as the birthplace of Marco Polo. **Transfer to the hotel** and free time to explore and be captivated by its vibrant atmosphere and stunning views over the Adriatic.

## **Day 5: DAY 05 – KORČULA ISLAND – PELJEŠAC PENINSULA – DUBROVNIK**

In the morning, we discover **KORCULA** on a complete **guided tour**, exploring its walled old town, full of history and medieval charm. We then cross over to the **PELJESAC** Peninsula, a land of vineyards with a long winemaking tradition, where we **enjoy a wine tasting (included)** in an exceptional rural **scenery**.



(The Pelješac Peninsula is famous for its rolling vineyards, crystal-clear coastline, and authentic Dalmatian charm.)

We continue to **DUBROVNIK**, the Pearl of the Adriatic. Arrival at around 3:00 PM, followed by free time to begin enjoying its unique atmosphere, stroll along its city walls, or wander through the streets of its impressive historic old town. Overnight stay.

## **Day 6: DAY 06 – DUBROVNIK**

**Free day to explore.** A day to enjoy the moment, discover new landscapes, and let every corner reveal its own story and beauty in peace. **Dinner included.**

## **Day 7: DAY 07 – DUBROVNIK**

We'll enjoy a **panoramic tour of Dubrovnik** with a local guide in the morning. We will undoubtedly be in one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, perched on a cliff, surrounded by walls, and kissed by

the Adriatic Sea. Its intact historic center is a jewel of world architectural heritage. We'll have the opportunity to enjoy a stunning view of the city from a scenic viewpoint along the road.

The tour includes tickets to the **Franciscan Monastery**, home to the oldest pharmacy in Europe, and the Assumption Cathedral. We'll also take a **boat trip to Lokrum**, a small island just 15 minutes away that is home to the ruins of an eleventh-century Benedictine monastery, a popular setting for the series *Game of Thrones*. Afterward, you'll have free time to explore at your leisure before returning to the hotel in the late afternoon. **Dinner will be included.**

**Note:** On some occasions, accommodation may be in Cavtat, a coastal town near Dubrovnik. From November to March, there is no boat service to Lokrum, so we will not visit the island during these months.

## Day 8: DAY 08 – DUBROVNIK – KOTOR – BUDVA – TIRANA

We'll set off early for **MONTENEGRO**. After completing border procedures, we'll enjoy the stunning coastal scenery and the Bay of Kotor. We'll take a **ferry across the bay to Kotor**, where you'll have time to explore this beautiful walled town with its strong Venetian influence.

Next, we'll stop in **BUDVA**, a charming walled village surrounded by the sea, for lunch. Then we'll travel to **ALBANIA**. After customs procedures, we'll go to the capital, **TIRANA**. Dinner will be included.

## Day 9: DAY 09 – TIRANA – STRUGA – OHRID

Today, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour of Tirana**, the capital of **Albania**, visiting its mosques, the Clock Tower, and the ministries. Around midday, we'll head inland, passing through Albania's tall

mountain scenery and little villages. Enjoy the beautiful countryside around **Lake Ohrid**, which forms the border with Macedonia.

We'll continue to the Republic of Macedonia (border procedures) and stop for lunch in **Struga**, a picturesque town on the lake's shores. We'll then proceed to Ohrid, a city rich in Ottoman influence and a designated World Heritage Site. You'll have time to explore the Plaosnik Monastery, or the ancient university founded in the ninth century. **Dinner will be included.**

## Day 10: DAY 10 – OHRID – BITOLA – KALAMBAKA

We'll journey through **MACEDONIA** into **GREECE**, with a stop in **BITOLA**, a city rich in history and charm, known for its Ottoman and neoclassical architecture. You'll have time to stroll along Širok Sokak, a lively area filled with cafes, restaurants, and shops. After completing border formalities, we'll enter Greece, where the northern region is deeply influenced by Slavic and Ottoman culture and features rugged landscapes. Our journey will continue to the Meteora region.

Just outside Kalabaka, we'll stop in **KASTRAKI**, a picturesque village offering stunning views of the valley, where you'll have time for lunch before going to the Meteora Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We'll drive through the entire valley and **include admission** to one of the most famous cliffside monasteries. Arrival in **KALABAKA**, with **dinner included.**

## Day 11: DAY 11 – KALAMBAKA – DELPHI – ATHENS

We'll journey south through the Thessaly region, where you'll experience stunning landscapes, before reaching **Delphi**. Here, we'll explore the exquisite **archaeological site** overlooking the Gulf of Corinth, with breathtaking views. There will be time for lunch. Following that, we'll head to the **Hosios Loukas Monastery**, renowned as one of the most beautiful Byzantine monasteries in Greece and a

World Heritage Site.

Its magnificent 11th-century mosaics are truly remarkable. We'll then continue our journey towards **Athens**, arriving in the evening.

## Day 12: DAY 12 – ATHENS

We'll embark on a **city tour of Athens** with a local guide, visiting landmarks such as the Presidential Mansion, the **Panathenaic Stadium**, where the first modern Olympic Games were held, the National Library, and the bustling squares of the city center. We'll also explore the newer neighborhoods that developed after the 2004 Olympic Games.



(The iconic Panathenaic Stadium in Athens, Greece, home of the first modern Olympic Games and one of the city's most famous historical landmarks.)

The tour will conclude at the Acropolis (admission not included). In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to the historical neighborhood of Plaka**, renowned for its charming Greek tavernas and opportunities to immerse yourself in the rich folklore of this country.

## Day 13: DAY 13 – ATHENS

After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories.

visiting Brač Island with views from Vidova Gora and the famous Zlatni Rat Beach. Travel along the scenic Bay of Kotor and visit Budva before continuing to Tirana and the lakeside UNESCO town of Ohrid. Explore the dramatic monasteries of Meteora, the ancient sanctuary of Delphi, and conclude in Athens with a visit to the iconic Acropolis of Athens and the historic neighborhood of Plaka.
