Day 1: DAY 1: MADRID

Welcome to Madrid!

Upon arrival at the airport, we'll be ready to transfer you to your hotel. You'll have some free time until the tour begins. Please check the information signs in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide and fellow travelers.

In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina**, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants. You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.

Day 2: DAY 2: MADRID

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor. We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal.



(A wide-angle view of the iconic Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, home to Real Madrid, showcases its vast seating and pristine pitch.)

Admission is included to the **Santiago Bernabéu Stadium**, the home of Real Madrid, considered by many to be the best football club in the world. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.

Day 3: DAY 3: MADRID - GRANADA

We will depart from Madrid early in the morning, heading south through La Mancha. Our first stop will be in **Puerto Lápice**, a charming Manchego village evocative of Don Quixote.



(Venta del Quijote in Puerto Lápice reflects the rustic beauty and cultural heritage of Spain's La Mancha region.)

We will then continue into Andalusia via Despeñaperros, arriving in **Granada**, where **lunch will be included. Free time in the afternoon.** We recommend visiting the Cathedral, which houses the tomb of the Catholic Monarchs, or strolling through the Albaicín neighborhood and enjoying the beautiful views of the Alhambra from the Mirador de San Nicolás.

Day 4: DAY 4: GRANADA - NERJA - MALAGA - RONDA - SEVILLE

Today we'll enjoy spectacular landscapes as we leave behind the Sierra Nevada mountain range. We'll then continue along the Mediterranean, on the so-called Tropical Coast, where the mild year-round microclimate allows for the cultivation of tropical fruits such as guavas, mangoes, and avocados, and in the past, sugar cane.

We stop in **NERJA**, a charming seaside town with impressive cliffs. We continue to **MÁLAGA**, the capital of the Costa del Sol, full of life and boasting a beautiful historic center. Time for lunch and a stroll through the city center.



(Málaga offers stunning Mediterranean views, a modern harbor, sandy beaches, and rich Andalusian culture.)

Afterward, we head into the Andalusian sierras and arrive in **RONDA**, a stunning white town famous for its dramatic gorge that splits the city in two.

We continue to **SEVILLE**, arriving in the late afternoon. Dinner is included at the hotel.

Day 5: DAY 5: SEVILLE

In the morning, we'll embark on a **city tour of Seville**, where you'll see the cathedral with its famous Giralda, the banks of the Guadalquivir River, and the popular neighborhoods of Santa Cruz and Triana.

After the tour, enjoy a relaxing **boat ride on the Guadalquivir River**, offering stunning panoramic views (included). In the evening, you'll have the option to attend a popular flamenco tablao.

Day 6: DAY 6: SEVILLE - MÉRIDA - ÉVORA - LISBON

We'll leave Seville, traveling through pleasant landscapes of rolling hills and expansive pasturelands as we head towards Extremadura. In **Mérida**, admission is included to the **Archaeological**

Ensemble of Mérida, which features a Roman Theater and Amphitheater. This site is renowned for its excellent preservation and its designation as a World Heritage Site.



(The remarkably preserved Roman Theater and Amphitheater form part of the UNESCO-listed Archaeological Ensemble of Mérida.)

You'll have time for lunch and a stroll through the vibrant pedestrian historic center, filled with restaurants and local charm. We will then continue to Portugal, stopping in **Évora**, another World Heritage Site, known for its whitewashed streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral. We'll arrive in **Lisbon** in the evening.

Day 7: DAY 7: LISBON

In the morning, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour of Lisbon**, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light.



(Lisbon's vibrant neighborhoods and red-tiled rooftops create one of Europe's most picturesque cityscapes.)

We'll also visit the **Belem neighborhood**, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century. **Free time in the afternoon** to walk and go to the **Bairro Alto** and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an optional trip to the towns of Sintra, Cascais, and Estoril. In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively Restauradores Square, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.

Day 8: DAY 8: LISBON - CÁCERES - MADRID

We'll depart from **Portugal** early, crossing the picturesque region of **Alentejo**. Our journey will include a coffee stop in **Estremoz**, a charming town known for its medieval castle, cobblestone streets, beautiful architecture, and calming atmosphere, all of which reflect Portuguese authenticity. We'll then cross into **Spain**. In **Cáceres**, you'll have the chance to enjoy lunch and explore its historic center, renowned as one of the best-preserved medieval and Renaissance urban complexes

in the world. We'll continue to **Madrid**, arriving in the evening.

Important note: If the number of passengers traveling on the Lisbon–Madrid route is low, the journey may be operated by plane.

Day 9: Day 9: MADRID

After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories.
