Day 1: DAY 1: MADRID

The lively capital of Spain is your Launchpad to a memorable encounter with one of Europe’s most soulful destinations. Relax in the lush surroundings of **El Retiro Park**, shop up a storm on the **Gran Vía**, or people-watch over coffee and churros with chocolate in the [Puerta del Sol](#).



(Visitors explore Puerta del Sol, Madrid’s iconic central square known for its vibrant atmosphere, historic buildings, and famous metro entrance.)

This evening, join your fellow travellers and Travel Director for an orientation drive followed by dinner.

Day 2: DAY 2: MADRID – TOLEDO - MADRID

Head to Toledo, the former capital of Spain, where you will join a Local Specialist for a walking tour of this city that dates back to Roman times. You'll visit a traditional factory and Dive into Culture, witnessing the age-old inlaid-steel craft, before seeing one of El Greco's most famous paintings in the **Church of Santo Tomé** – 'The Burial of the Count of Orgaz'.

You'll also visit the synagogue before returning to Madrid to admire the exterior of the **Royal Palace** and **Cibeles Fountain** with your Local Specialist. Spend the evening on your own, or delve into the sights and flavours of Spain's capital with an Optional Experience.

Day 3: DAY 3: TOLEDO – CORDOBA - SEVILLE

Journey through the **plains of La Mancha**, a region made famous by the tale of Don Quixote, and **arrive in Córdoba**. With a Local Specialist, visit the [Mosque of the Caliphs](#) and explore the Jewish Quarter, uncovering stories of cultural exchange and architectural legacy.



(The stunning Mosque-Cathedral of Córdoba)

glows at sunset, highlighting one of Spain's most remarkable examples of Islamic and Christian architecture.)

Continue to Seville, where you'll stay for the next two nights. Join your hosts at a local olive oil farm for a Be My Guest experience. Learn how olives are grown and pressed, hear about life in the countryside, and sample some of the oils produced on site.

Day 4: DAY 4: SEVILLE

This morning, meet our Local Specialist for a sightseeing **tour of Seville**. View the symbolic **Giralda Bell Tower**, and see the Moorish-inspired **Maria Luisa Park**, with its tiled fountains, pavilions, and ponds.



(The beautiful Parque de María Luisa in Seville offers peaceful gardens, fountains, and elegant architecture in the heart of Andalusia.)

Marvel at the ornate tomb of Christopher Columbus in the cathedral, then take a walk through the former Jewish Quarter. In the evening, consider an Optional Experience to see, hear, and feel the mysterious and ineffable charm of a traditional flamenco show.

Day 5: DAY 5: SEVILLE - GRANADA

Multicultural Granada takes centre stage today, as you visit the magnificent **Alhambra** in the company of a Local Specialist. An exquisite example of Moorish architecture, the **Alhambra**

complex was built towards the end of Islamic rule in Spain.



(The Alhambra rises above Granada with breathtaking views of the city and surrounding Andalusian landscape.)

Wander through the exotic water gardens of the Generalife, the royal Summer Palace, once linked to the other palaces by a covered walkway across the ravine.

Day 6: DAY 6: GRANADA – GAUDIX - VALENCIA

This morning, journey via the **Mora Pass to Guadix** in the northern foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains. You'll see the whitewashed troglodyte dwellings lodged into the ochre-coloured cliffs of the surrounding area, then **travel to Valencia**, where you'll see the Bullring and admire the medieval architecture of the **Quart and Serranos towers**.



(The historic Torres de Serranos, one of Valencia's most iconic medieval landmarks and former city gates in Spain.)

Embrace the city's spirit of innovation and stop to view the City of Arts and Sciences, a large-scale urban recreation centre for culture and science. Enjoy organic horchata, the celebrated drink of Valencia. This evening, you will dine at your hotel.

Day 7: DAY 7: VALENCIA – PENISCOLA – BARCELONA

Head north, along the coast through the Levant region, and **stop at Peñíscola**, the 'City in the Sea'. View the **ancient castle of the 'Spanish Pope'**, built by the Knights Templar and used in the film, 'El Cid'. We then continue along the **Costa Dorada to Barcelona** with its whimsical Gaudí architecture.



(The iconic Sagrada Família rising above the vibrant streets of Barcelona—a must-see landmark for travelers exploring Spain.)

Join a Local Specialist to admire the exterior of the unfinished **Sagrada Família**, see the upscale boutiques and Gaudí creations on the Passeig de Gràcia, and pay tribute to Christopher Columbus at the monument that bears his name.
