Day 1: DAY 1: WELCOME TO MUNICH

The sophisticated city streets of Munich are your launch pad to an adventure through the capitals of Imperial Europe. Join your fellow travellers and your Travel Director this afternoon on an orientation tour, and spend some free time immersing yourself in the sights and sounds of the Bavarian capital.



(The historic heart of Munich comes alive at dusk, featuring Marienplatz, the Gothic New Town Hall, and the iconic Frauenkirche.)

View the **Marienplatz**, the centre of Munich city life since the 12th century, and its iconic **Glockenspiel**, before enjoying dinner together to kick-start your journey.

Day 2: DAY 2: MUNICH – REGENSBURG - PRAGUE

This morning, **visit Regensburg**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an unspoilt medieval gem.



(The medieval Stone Bridge and historic old town of Regensburg create one of Bavaria's most picturesque riverfront views.)

Cross the Czech border and **head to Prague**, your home for the next two nights. Join an educational lecture with a local bee expert. You'll have the evening to spend your way. Consider joining an Optional Experience to explore beautiful Prague by night with a Local Specialist

Day 3: DAY 3: PRAGUE

Delve into centuries of history as you join a Local Specialist for a **guided sightseeing tour of Prague**. View the impressive Gothic architecture of **St. Vitus Cathedral** in the grounds of the 1,000-year-old **Prague Castle**, then cross the river on your walking tour to the **Old Town Square** to see the Astronomical Clock.



(The iconic Charles Bridge stretching across the Vltava River with Prague's Old Town skyline in the background.)

The afternoon is yours to experience the city on your terms. Savour the delicious flavours of Trdelník in the Old Town Square, pay tribute to the saints that line the **Charles Bridge**, or consider a relaxing lunch cruise on the Vltava.

Day 4: DAY 4: PRAGUE - BRATISLAVA - BUDAPEST

Day 5: DAY 5: BUDAPEST

Admire the iconic and unexpected **highlights of Budapest on a guided sightseeing tour** with a Local Specialist. See the famous **Chain Bridge**, which connects the two ancient settlements that straddle the Danube, and the UNESCO-listed **Castle Hill district**.



(Budapest's famous Széchenyi Chain Bridge beautifully connects Buda and Pest across the Danube River.)

Here, you can enjoy superb views across the Danube below to the imposing Parliament building. Spend the rest of the day at leisure before joining the Schieszl family for a hearty Hungarian dinner. Connect with Locals and hear the story of their winery.

Day 6: DAY 6: BUDAPEST – GYOR- VIENNA

(The charming historic centre of Gy?r showcases elegant Baroque architecture and vibrant Hungarian heritage.)

Day 7: DAY 7: VIENNA

Admire **Hofburg Palace**, the former winter residence of the Habsburg Dynasty, the grand **State Opera House**, and **Ringstrasse**, a beautiful sweeping boulevard built in the 19th-century to replace the city walls.



(The iconic Vienna State Opera House is

one of Austria's most celebrated cultural landmarks and a must-visit attraction in Vienna.)

Then, see the ornate colourful roof of **St. Stephen's Cathedral**, one of the city's most beloved icons. Maybe visit the Baroque **Schönbrunn Palace** with its tranquil gardens or enjoy Vienna's musical talents at one of the performances for which the city is famous.

Day 8: DAY 8: VIENNA - SALZBURG

(Salzburg enchants visitors with its baroque architecture, alpine scenery, and rich musical history as the birthplace of Mozart.)

Arriving in Salzburg, we embark on a leisurely **walking tour** of its **Old Town** with a Local Specialist. Dine in your hotel this evening.
