Day 1: DAY 1: LONDON - WINDSOR - OXFORD – BIRMINGHAM

Start with a [stop in Windsor](#), home to the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world, then **continue to** the historic university city of **Oxford**. Explore its streets of renowned colleges and historic architecture. Finally, journey onward to **Birmingham** for your **overnight stay**.

Day 2: DAY 2: BIRMINGHAM - CHESTER – LIVERPOOL

The Romans left their magic touch on the pretty **town of Chester**. You'll view the city walls that they
