Day 1: DAY 1: SPLIT

Welcome to Croatia. On arrival at **Split Airport**, transfer to your hotel and settle in before your Adriatic journey begins. The **rest of the day is at leisure**. You may wish to take a stroll through Split's historic streets, relax by the waterfront, or sample Dalmatian cuisine at a local restaurant before embarking on your cruise tomorrow.

Day 2: DAY 2: SPLIT – TROGIR - HVAR

Join your **Local Expert** for an intimate **exploration of Split's Diocletian's Palace**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the greatest surviving Roman structures.



(The historic interiors of Diocletian's Palace showcases Roman columns and ancient architecture in Split.)

Step inside the emperor's mausoleum, now the **Cathedral of Saint Domnius**, and see the **Temple of Jupiter**, later converted into a baptistery. After passing through the **Golden Gate**, **board your coastal cruiser** and meet your Cruise Manager. Enjoy lunch on board as you **sail to Hvar**. On arrival, **stroll through the old town** to its Renaissance cathedral and hilltop fortress. Later, **visit a local winery** in the town centre to sample signature varietals. This evening, perhaps dine al fresco, enjoy a seaside aperitif, or explore Hvar's vibrant cafe culture.

Day 3: DAY 3: HVAR – KUNA PELJEŠAC - TRSTENIK

Cruise from Hvar to the Pelješac Peninsula, known since the 14th century for its vineyards and maritime trade. Pause for a swim in one of the Adriatic's secluded bays before a freshly prepared lunch onboard. As you near Trstenik, **join an olive oil tasting onboard** to explore the peninsula's deep-rooted tradition of small-batch production. **Journey inland to Kuna**, a village tied to monastic heritage and agriculture. End the day with a **Farm-to-Table dinner** on the Antunovi? estate, where Dalmatian specialties are prepared using ingredients sourced directly from the family's farm.

Day 4: DAY 4: TRSTENIK – MLJET - DUBROVNIK

Sail to the island of Mljet, home to one of Croatia's most treasured national parks. Accompanied by your Cruise Manager, explore a landscape shaped by legend and geology — Mljet is said to be the island where Odysseus was held captive by the nymph Calypso. Visit the park's renowned saltwater lakes, whose striking color comes from a unique mix of marine and freshwater ecosystems.



(The beautiful Monastery of St. Mary sits on a serene island in Croatia, blending medieval architecture with breathtaking Adriatic scenery.)

Board a small boat across the larger lake to **St. Mary Isle**, where a 12th-century **Benedictine monastery** sits in serene isolation. Return to your ship for lunch, then enjoy a memorable cruise along Dubrovnik's ancient city walls, offering panoramic views of the terracotta rooftops and fortress towers. Arrive in port for time at leisure before dining on board and spending the night docked in the

city.

Day 5: DAY 5: DUBROVNIK

This morning, join a **guided walking tour of Dubrovnik's Old Town**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site enclosed by remarkably preserved medieval walls. Discover the city's rich maritime past, from its days as the Republic of Ragusa to its role in resisting Ottoman and Venetian expansion. Then take the **cable car to Mount Sr?**, where views stretch across the Adriatic and the **Elaphiti Islands**. The **afternoon and evening** are yours to **enjoy at leisure**.



(Discover the breathtaking beauty of the Elaphiti Islands, a peaceful Croatian archipelago known for turquoise waters, hidden coves, and scenic boat excursions.)

You may wish to explore further with an **Optional Experience**:

Sea kayaking beneath the city walls or take a Game of Thrones filming locations tour, which reveals how Dubrovnik became King's Landing.

Alternatively, explore the city's museums, walk the medieval ramparts, or unwind at one of the open-air cafes along the promenade.

Day 6: DAY 6: DUBROVNIK - KOR?ULA

Sail north this morning **towards Kor?ula**, passing forested islands and secluded inlets along the Dalmatian coast. Pause in a quiet bay to **enjoy lunch on board**, surrounded by calm turquoise waters. Arrive in Kor?ula, often referred to as 'Little Dubrovnik' for its medieval walls and red-roofed skyline. **Meet your Local Expert for a guided walk through the Old Town's** narrow streets, laid out in a herringbone pattern to protect against wind and sun. Learn about Kor?ula's link to Marco Polo and its centuries of Venetian influence. The **evening is at leisure**.

You may choose to explore further with an **Optional Experience** buggy ride across the island, a wine tasting at Tasovac Winery, or a traditional Dalmatian dinner featuring locally sourced seafood and

island-grown produce.

Day 7: DAY 7: KORČULA - BRAC

Cruise from Korčula this morning with a swim stop in one of the Adriatic's quiet bays, an ideal moment to unwind before **lunch is served on board**. Arrive on the **island of Brač**, known for its white limestone, exported as far as the White House, and laid-back coastal villages. The **afternoon** is yours at **leisure**.



(Explore the remarkable Blaca Hermitage, a centuries-old monastery carved into the rocky landscape of Brač Island, Croatia.)

You might **choose to explore** the island's cultural sites, such as the **Blaca Hermitage** or local art workshops, or simply enjoy the waterfront.

This **evening**, join the **Captain's Dinner**, an onboard celebration featuring regional dishes and live entertainment.

Day 8: DAY 8: BRAC - TROGIR

Sail north this morning **towards Trogir**, a small island town connected to the mainland by a 17th-century stone bridge. With origins dating back to the 3rd century B.C., Trogir is a living museum of Romanesque, Gothic, and Renaissance architecture. On arrival, join a **guided walking tour** through its UNESCO-listed old town, where you'll explore narrow alleyways, hidden courtyards, and historic landmarks including the **Cathedral of St. Lawrence**, noted for its 13th-century portal carved by Master Radovan.



(Admire the timeless beauty of the Cathedral of St. Lawrence, one of Croatia's most celebrated historic and architectural treasures.)

The **rest of the day** is yours at **leisure** — perhaps enjoy a harbourside meal, visit the town's small museums, or explore the local market.

You'll **dock overnight in Marina Baoti?**, giving you more time to experience Trogir's well-preserved historic centre.

Day 9: DAY 9: SPLIT

After breakfast, **disembark your ship in Marina Baoti?** and **transfer to the airport** for your onward journey.
