Day 1: DAY 1 - ARRIVE ZAGREB | WALKING TOUR OF ZAGREB

Later, continue to Zadar, a city of exceptional history and rich cultural heritage.

Day 3: DAY 3 - WALKING TOUR OF ZADAR

This morning, enjoy a guided walking tour of Zadar.

During the tour, explore the Old City, stop by the Church of St. Donat built on the ancient Roman forum, visit the Cathedral of St. Anastasia, and see landmarks like the Sea Gate, Land Gate, City Walls, and the Square of Five Wells. Enjoy a free tasting of Maraschino liqueur and Pag cheese.

Take your time to enjoy the soothing sounds of the Sea Organ and marvel at the stunning sunset.

Optional Activity: Experience a Romantic Sunset Cruise for an unforgettable evening.

Day 4: DAY 4 - ZADAR – SPLIT (160KMS | 2HRS) | WALKING TOUR OF SPLIT

In the morning, continue to Split, a city buzzing with culture and events.

Discover the 1700-year-old Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore its ancient alleyways, the Peristil, the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the Golden Gate, and the statue of Gregory of Nin.
