## **Tour Itinerary**

## Day 01 Arrival Delhi – (Flight Details Awaited)

Arrive **New Delhi** International airport. You will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. On arrival check into the hotel. **(Standard check in time: 14:00 hrs).** Our representative will brief you about your tour and handover all the travel documents required for your tour. Rest of the day is free to relax.

**Delhi's** strategic location was one of the main reasons why successive dynasties chose it as their seat of power and today it is a conglomerate of seven cities. The division between the old walled city and New Delhi marks a division in lifestyles, with the old city retaining its past traditions whilst New Delhi strives to match the pace of the 21st century. Overnight stay at Delhi.

## Day 02 Delhi Full Day Sightseeing

Breakfast at the hotel. In morning Proceed for a City tour of Old and New Delhi.

Old Delhi – Drive past the magnificent Red Fort (closed on Mondays) and Jama Masjid. Drive past Kotla Firoze Shah, ruins of an old fort of the 14th century. Visit Raj Ghat, where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated in 1948. Drive through the old city subject to traffic conditions.

Afternoon visit **New Delhi** - Drive past the **Presidential Palace**, the **Rashtrapati Bhavan**, through the impressive **Rajpath t**o the World War I memorial arch, photo stop at the **India Gate**, Visit the **Qutub Minar**, the 2-meter-high Minaret. and the ruins of Quwat-ul-Eslam (Light of Islam) Mosque. See Delhi's most curious antiques, the uncorroded Iron Pillar, which dates to the 4th century AD & **Humayun's Tomb.** After visit return to hotel. Overnight stay at Delhi.

## Day 03 Drive Delhi – Agra (240 kms / Approx 4 hrs drive)

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast **drive to Agra** – The capital of the Mughals in the 16th and 17th Centuries. Though Agra's history is largely recognized with the Mughal Empire, this city was established much earlier and has links to the Mahabharat period in 1000 BC. However, the Golden Age of this city began with the Mughals and was known then as Akbarabad. Home to three generations of one of the most dynamic dynasties in the medieval world - with each generation playing a different role in its making! Agra is home to the finest examples of Mughal architecture in India, of which the Taj is simply the most famous. The beauty of these buildings will bowl you over, but knowing something of the dramatic history that played itself out on these stages makes the entire Agra experience come alive.



On arrival in Agra check into the hotel. Later half day city tour. Visit the Taj Mahal (Closed on Fridays) The Greatest love Story ever told! On the death of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, Shahjehan built her this memorial. It took 22 years to build this monument. Visit Agra Fort - behind its forbidding red sandstone Battlements lie palace that tells the story of the Moghul Empire. After visit return to hotel. Overnight stay at Agra.

## Day 04 Drive Agra – Fatehpur Sikri + Jaipur (310 kms / Approx 5 hrs drive)

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast drive to Ranthambore, **En-route visit Fatehpur Sikri** - 37 kms west of Agra lies the ghost city of Fatehpur Sikri - an epic poem in red sandstone, built by Emperor Akbar the Great in 1569. Later drive to **Jaipur**, the first planned city of India, located in the desert lands of Rajasthan. It was built 285 years ago by warrior - astronomer Raja Sawai Jai Singh-II and reflects the royal taste of the Rajput's in its architecture. It is the capital city of Rajasthan. The graceful pink coloured architecture of the city has earned it the title of 'The Pink City'. On arrival, transfer to your hotel. Evening is free to explore local market. Overnight stat at Jaipur.

## Day 05 Jaipur Sightseeing

Breakfast at the hotel, later proceed for Half day Excursion to Amber Fort Enroute Photo stop at 'Hawa Mahal' (Palace of Winds) Amber Fort – 7 miles north of Jaipur is Amber with it's a honey- colored fortress-palace in the Aravalli Hills which can be mounted by Jeep. It has been described as "the sleeping beauty of Rajasthan". Returns will be provided by Jeep.

Later afternoon proceed for a guided city tour visiting the **City Palace** - the former Royal Residence part of which is now a museum. One of the major attractions here is the armoury with its impressive array of pistols, blunderbusses, flintlocks, swords, rifles, and daggers used by the Maharajas of Jaipur. The Textile and Costume Museum on the first floor is another fine display, with items from all over India. Also visit Jai Singh's Observatory - **Jantar Mantar Observatory**, the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world and a World Heritage Site. It is the best preserved of five observatories built by Jai Singh, the founder of Jaipur. It has 17 large instruments, many of them still in working condition. built in the 17th century. After visit return to hotel. Overnight stay at Jaipur.

## Day 06 Jaipur – Delhi by drive (Approx 330 kms / 6 hours) - Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Hotel standard Check out time: 1200hrs.

Later transfer to Delhi International airport to connect flight for your onward Journey.
